

SIG SAUER ROMEO5 RECALL

Dear Customer,

SIG SAUER, in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, is recalling the ROMEO5 Red Dot Sight manufactured in 2023 or 2024. The recalled firearm sights pose an ingestion hazard because the product contains a CR2032 button cell battery can be easily accessed and do not bear the required warnings. In addition, there is a button cell battery provided in the retail package which is not in child-resistant packaging. These are violations to the mandatory federal regulations for consumer products containing button cell batteries required by Reese's Law. When button cell batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns and death, posing an ingestion hazard to children.

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled firearm sights and contact SIG SAUER for instructions on how to submit a picture of the serial number to receive a free recall kit which includes a new cap with the required labeling and an updated instruction manual.



This recall involves Models SOR52001 and 7400579, which is a part included with Model SORJ53101. They are black in color and labeled with the SIG SAUER logo and ROMEO5 name on one side of the product. The model number can be found on the product packaging. The recalled ROMEO5 sights have a knurled battery cap and contain either the letter K or M as the last digit of the serial number printed on the bottom of the sight. Please see instructions below to determine if your ROMEO5 sight is affected by this recall.
